Since its founding in 1983, Capitol Network has raised and donated more than a quarter million dollars to charities that provide much needed services to women and children across California. Capitol Network is currently seeking applications from qualified non-profit organizations for charitable giving grants. In past years, Capitol Network has made donations in amounts ranging from \$1,000 to \$5,000. Additionally, one of the organizations may be the beneficiary of Capitol Network's annual golf tournament.

Capitol Network is a non-partisan organization of public and private professionals who work in and around California's state capitol. Capitol Network's members are government relations, administration and legislative professions. The organization provides members with opportunities to exchange ideas of mutual interest, develop lasting personal and professional relationships and demonstrate leadership in community service.

Qualifications and Application Requirements:

- Qualified applicants must be a California non-profit (501c3 or 501c6) organization serving the needs of women and/or children.
- The application package must include evidence of the organization's non-profit status, and a letter of recommendation from a member of the Legislature or Capitol Network. Additional materials regarding the organization may be included in the packet but is not necessary.
- Recipients of a Capitol Network grant in 2018 are not eligible in 2019.
- Completed applications must be postmarked by August 30, 2019 for consideration.

The Capitol Network Charitable Giving Committee will select charities/non-profit entities in September to receive a grant. Applicants and their nominators will be notified in October if they have been selected.
